


Automated Searching of APRF for Military Surplus

The Swafford Industries Military Surplus Locator Database engine has been configured to automatically retrieve current Active Purchase Request Files (APRF) directly from DLA's Reading Room website (http://efoia.daps.dla.mil/b_aprf.htm). This **daily** process allows personnel to quickly scan current Purchase Requests for potential Military Surplus items. (See diagram below.)

Active Purchase Request Files




